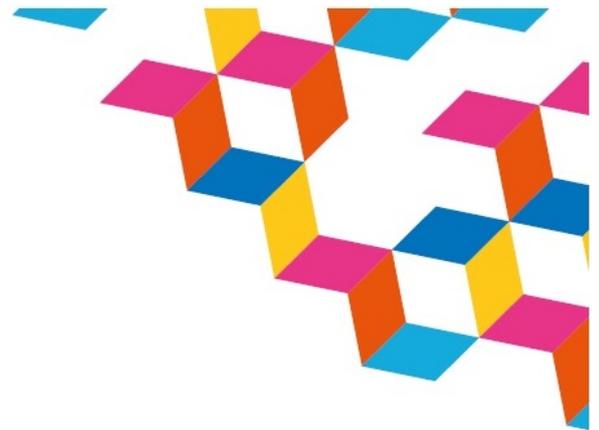

<b>Explain the project in one sentence</b>	This project is about improving the extent to which people with diabetes are able to access care provided in accordance with NICE guidance.
<b>Tell us about the project and sponsor in no more than 175 words</b>	<p>Many high quality clinical trials have investigated how best to treat diabetes and to minimise the risk of complications. The resulting evidence is condensed periodically into guidance by the National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE). However, there is considerable variation within the NHS in the extent to which this guidance is put into practice. As a result, patients are exposed unnecessarily to increased risks of suffering diabetic complications and antidiabetic medication-related adverse effects.</p> <p>The goal of the project will be to identify ways to reduce this variation. You will work with people with diabetes and with experts in primary care and diabetology. You will also have the opportunity to work with the Royal College of General Practitioners (RCGP) Research and Surveillance Centre (RSC) database, providing a nationally representative sample of 400 general practices (4,000,000 registered patients).</p> <p>The secure data and analytics hub of RCGP RSC is based at University of Surrey; you will be trained in “big data” analytics and will develop skills in bringing data to the consultation, and in integrating services.</p>
<b>What skills or attributes are you looking for in a fellow?</b>	Interested in engaging in primary care, analysing healthcare systems, working with large datasets,

	influencing decision-makers, and investigating efficacy of new service developments.
