<p><b>Tell us about the project and sponsor in no more than 175 words</b></p>	<p>Diana Hamilton-Fairley has moved from being Medical Director to Director of Strategy for MFT to implement care transformation across the Medway Healthcare system. She has successfully sponsored a previous KSS Darzi fellow. The Medway Healthcare system is developing 6 community hubs to serve populations of 100k people. 4 pathways have been developed to work across the primary and secondary divide (Frailty, Diabetes, COPD and CCF). There is an appetite in Medway to develop new ways of working that will work across primary and secondary care combining generalism and specialisation. Medway CCG has a Transformation Board working with Health and Social care partners to oversee the implementation of the new models of care. The Darzi fellow would be based at MFT and work across the system including with GP leads of the Medway Community Hubs using co-production methodology to create new clinical roles across the Health and Social care system. The aim is to improve patient care and experience as well as the working environment for professionals.</p>

In September 2018 she moved into the role of Director of Strategy to clinically lead the strategic transformation of services at MFT as part of the Medway Healthcare system. She is the co-chair of the STP Clinical and Professional Board and works with the STP to implement the STP clinical strategy across Kent and Medway. She is also on the Clinical Advisory Board for the new Kent and Medway Medical School (KMMS).</p> <p>During her time at Medway, Diana has been instrumental in changing the safety culture at the Trust improving outcomes for all patients which led to the Trust coming out of Quality Special Measures in 2017 (after over 3 years). She has facilitated the implementation of new pathways within the Trust and across the Medway Community. She was the sponsor for the Darzi fellow who developed and implemented Medway's COPD pathway which was launched on October 1<sup>st</sup> 2018. Diana has run a Clinical Leadership programme for all senior staff and supported the MediLead leadership programme for junior doctors and has championed clinical leadership as an integral factor for improving the quality of care we provide.</p>

Diana was a Consultant Obstetrician and Gynaecologist at Guys and St Thomas's NHS Foundation Trust (GSTT) from 1996 to 2016.

Diana has extensive experience in Education having previously been joint Director of Quality and Education for Health Education South London (South London LETB) 2013-14 and Postgraduate Dean for Acute Specialties for London (2011-13). Diana led on commissioning and quality management of commissioned and non-commissioned postgraduate medical education across London.

Diana was elected as the London Fellow's representative for the Council of RCOG in July 2011-2017.

Diana has been Clinical Director for Women's Services and Deputy / Acting Medical Director at GSTT (2004-11) and Head of London School for O&G (2008-11).
