A rejuvenated and expanded general practice workforce will collaborate with integrated teams and become ready Multi Speciality Community Provider contracts in 2019 and bridge the gap between health and social care.</p> <p>These groups of general practices working closely together with partners are described in the Primary Care Home Initiative – one of the ‘new models of care’, but for this vision to become reality a lot needs to change. I have been a GP for nearly 20 years and have witnessed many attempts of forging multi-disciplinary teams. As a director for a large GP Federation I’m involved with supporting networks of general practices to enhance their capacity by creating new roles like Wellbeing Advisors, changing existing roles (from Receptionists to Care Navigators) and bringing in professionals from other organisations (e.g. Social workers, therapists).</p>
