<p><b>Explain the project in one sentence</b></p>	<p>The QVH would like to develop their paediatric burns service to now be delivered on two sites, the QVH and the RACH, Brighton, meeting the co-location requirements of a modern burns service, and providing improved plastic surgery services to the Major Trauma Service in Brighton.</p>
<p><b>Tell us about the project and sponsor in no more than 175 words</b></p>	<p>We are a specialty surgical hospital providing burns and reconstructive surgery to the population of KSS, with some of the best patient feedback results in the country. You would work with an enthusiastic executive team, senior clinicians, a project manager and be supervised by the Medical Director. Ed is also an anaesthetist, with interests in education and support for trainees.</p> <p>Our acute burns service is currently commissioned with accepted derogation from certain standards, particularly regarding the lack of co-location of services for paediatric inpatient burns with other trauma and medical specialties. A recent agreement has been reached by QVH and BSUH to develop a shared burns service for the region, whilst securing plastic surgery services to the Major Trauma Centre at Brighton. The project would be to work alongside the Medical Director to lead the development of new clinical pathways of care, to ensure safe, effective paediatric burns care across two sites.</p> <p>The project will involve public engagement, and cross clinical, operational, HR and financial boundaries, working with two trusts, the STP and NHSE.</p>
